





# Charging



## Use specified Charger only.

- 1 Open Port Cover to connect Charger**
- 2 Plug Charger into AC outlet**


- Small Light illuminates red while charging; may take up to approximately 150 minutes.
- When charging completes Small Light goes out.

## After Charging

### Unplug Charger, then disconnect handset


- Squeeze release tabs to remove connector.
- Replace Port Cover to protect External Device Port.

**3** : Unread Mail

: Unread Delivery Report

: Receiving Mail

: Sending Mail

**4** : Memory Card Inserted

**5** : Bluetooth<sup>®</sup> Transmission Ready

**6** : Manner Mode Active

: Drive Mode Active

**7** : Battery Strength

Indicator may appear vertically (e.g. ).

**8** : Answer Phone Active

: Answer Phone Active & Message Recorded

: Answer Phone Canceled & Message Recorded

**9** : New Voicemail

**10** : Message Delivery Failure

**11** : Alarm Set

**12** : Keypad Lock Active

**13** : Ringtone Silent

: Ringtone Silent & Vibration Active

### Other Phone Book Entry Items


<b>Add Email Address</b>	Enter up to three addresses
<b>Category</b>	Sort entries into Categories
<b>Picture</b>	Set an image to appear for incoming calls/mail
<b>Tone for</b>	Set ringtone/ringvideo by caller/sender
<b>Vib</b>	Set vibration by caller/sender
<b>Secret</b>	Restrict access to Phone Book entries

# ヘルスノート (Health Note) S! Application

Use ヘルスノート (Health Note) S! Application to help manage your health.  
(Japanese ability is required to use this application.)

- **体重・歩数メモリー (Weight/Step Memory)**

Records body weight and step count.

- **体重歩数推移グラフ (Weight/Step Graph)**

View changes in body weight and step count.

- **肥満度チェック (Overweight Test)**

Enter your height and weight to calculate Body Mass Index (BMI). The application also shows ideal body fat percentage and ideal body weight.

- ★BMI & Body Fat Percentage

Though estimated as overweight by BMI, a person may not be so estimated by body fat percentage. Conversely, though estimated not overweight by BMI, one may be so estimated by body fat percentage. Discrepancies arise because BMI is calculated by statistics, and body fat percentage by measured data.

NOTE

Estimations are based on statistics sampled from Japanese subjects.

### Ideal Body Fat Percentage

Provided by Tanita Corporation.

This index is designed specifically for Tanita's body composition monitor based on the evidences at WHO and Japan Society for the Study of Obesity.

- **データ出力 (Data Output)**

Export saved data to Data Folder as a text file.
