# Messaging

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## **Basics**

#### Send messages via S! Mail or SMS.

S! Mail [Separate subscription required]	Exchange text messages with SoftBank or e-mail compatible handsets, PCs, etc.; attach image or sound files etc.  930P is compatible with Graphic Mail (プア13-5)
SMS Exchange short text messages with SoftBank handsets.



## **Messaging Folders & Memory Status**

Messages are organized in folders by message type.



\* Set Auto-sort to sort received messages to specified folders or Spam Folder automatically (2 P.13-15, 13-16).

#### Deleting Messages Automatically

When memory for Messaging Folders is low, old messages are automatically deleted one by one. Protect important messages from unintentional deletion (☐ P.13-20), or set message deletion settings to OFF (CFP.18-16), Messages in Drafts and SMS on USIM Card are not deleted automatically.


#### When Messaging Memory is Full

(Received Full) appears in Standby and no more new incoming messages are received. Delete old messages in Incoming Mail folder ( P.13-20). Retrieve new messages ( P.13-14) after deleting some S! Mail.



#### **Graphic Mail**





# **Organizing/Using Messages**

## **Checking Messages in Messaging Folders**

- - In Incoming Mail folder, select a folder then message.
- Select a message
  - In Received/Sent Message window, toggle #/\* to view previous/next messages.

#### **Auto-sort**

- Previously received messages are not sorted.
- Incoming messages are sorted by subject if both address and subject match sort condition applied to specific folder. Messages with no subject are sorted by address.
- Either address or mail subject can be specified per folder.

## **Filter Spam**


